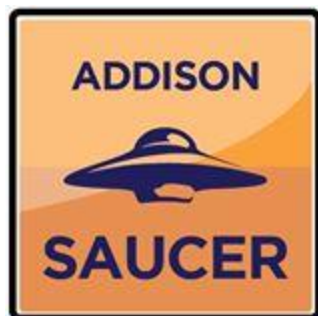

Beer Stuff

I finally built one BrewPi/Arduino board set. Here is a picture of it working on my desk:



The next step is to build two enclosures, one for the control boards you see in the picture above. The second will house the relay board and power sockets to power the AC compressor, AC fan and fermwrap heater. I will only use three of the four relays on the board. Here are the components for the power box:



I also need to build some temperature probes. I am going to do some experimentation on where to sample temperature of a carboy. I currently have an epoxy block I attach to the side of the carboy with an Ace bandage. I am going to build some probes that are more like the long thermowells you see. I will compare the temperature readings between outside the carboy and a probe suspended in the liquid.
